


WidgetMakr Quick Reference: How to Copy a Widget

Rather than build a new widget each time you need one, you can copy an existing one and then tweak it. Follow the directions below on how to copy a widget.

1. From your WidgetMakr dashboard, scroll down to the widget you wish to copy and click on the blue **Duplicate** link.

2. From the new widget, click on the headline to rename it. This change will be the new name of the widget.


